- 2 Addition of 10 point Program, dealing with timely issues, concerning California, offering a libertarian solution to the problem presented - to be presented by the Platform Committee to the LPC convention delegates for approval as agenda item D each year. FAILED.

- 3 Bylaw 9 Section 4 (new)

All members of the Executive Committee will serve on a subcommittee. Failure to serve on a subcommittee or to attend two consecutive meetings, shall be cause for removal. PASSED.

- 2 prohibiting deficit spending - FAILED

Bylaw 8

Section 3 (new)

The Party shall not spend the monies due to the regions.

Suspension of the rules to consider the Platform Committee Report.

All of the Platform Committee recommendations of changes within the existing planks passed with some revisions from the floor.

Recessed for lunch - reconvened at 2:00 pm

A recommendation that the six-paragraph introduction to Individual Rights be deleted with portions added to other sections of the Platform was defeated after a heated debate, mostly in opposition, particularly to the idea of deleting the references to the Right to Life, Liberty and Property.

A new plank condemning federal bankruptcy law FAILED (as it did when introduced at the national convention).
