Libertarian Party of California Executive Committee 19 February 1996

The post-convention meeting of the LPC Executive Committee took place from about 15:48 to about 18:00 at the Long Beach Hyatt, with all members in attendance except for Region 38 representative Mark Valverde.

The regular meeting business was preceded by remarks by Council of State Chairs Coordinator Gene Cisewski.

It was decided to reopen bidding for the 1997 convention, with the Operations Committee empowered choose among the bids submitted.

It was decided to keep the state 800-number through November.

An arrangement for Pat Wright to do membership recruiting by direct mail, on a commission basis (10% of gross, not to exceed 50% of net), was approved.

A bid from Gene and Shannon Trosper to produce the state newsletter was accepted.

Four members were elected to serve on the Operations Committee along with the Chair: Ted Brown, Linda Grau, Mark Murphy, and Jon Petersen.

Other action included taking a position against Proposition 203, approving the budget, and granting a life membership to Steve Alexander.

Following up on a suggestion by Art Hays, the Chair said she would be appointing a minutes approval committee for the December meeting, and another for the minutes of this year's meetings, to review the minutes before they are brought to the full Executive Committee for approval.

Internal Education Chair Ed Moss addressed the committee on various topics.

The next meeting is scheduled for 4 May at 10:00am, in Sacramento.
